

WORRY WORM

Select your yarn. Match your crochet hook size to the yarn. The yarn I used was Red Heart, worsted weight 4. I used a size I-9 crochet hook. This is a good project for scrap yarn. Any yarn should work.

Make a slip knot on your hook. Chain 30.

Slip Stitch into the second chain from the hook.

Next, work 4 single crochets into each chain across until one chain remains. Be careful not to skip a chain.

To form the head: Into that last remaining chain, work 10 double crochets. Then slip stitch into the same chain that you worked the 10 double crochets into.

Chain 1. Cut the yarn, pull the end out through the chain you just made and pull yarn tight.

Weave in the ends. Add eyes of choice--Googly, felt circles, buttons or French knots.

Verses:

I'm a little worry worm,
Keep me near and squeeze
Me tight,
Tell me your worries and I will
Make everything alright.

I'm not lost, I'm just alone—
If I made you smile,
Please take me home!
