| Materials: | Worsted Weight Yarn – We Recommend Cumulus by Juniper Moon Farm | |

Jen's Note: There is a video link on the pattern listing and the last page of this pattern if you have any questions about knitting through the back loop or the fan stitch! If making this for a person without hair, you might want to remove some stitches from the cast on. Decreasing by 6 stitches which will remove approx. 1" from your finished size.

PATTERN

CO 96 st onto your circular needle, place stitch marker and join in the round.

RIBBED BRIM

Ribbed Brim Round 1: (Ktbl1, P1) Repeat parentheses until end of the round Repeat Ribbed Brim Round 1 eight more times (9 rounds total). **Ribbed Brim Round 10:** Knit one round.

FAN STITCH

Fan Stitch Round 1: (K1, triple wrap each of the next 5 stitches) Repeat parentheses until end of round.

***Jen's Note: You will perform the steps below on each of the triple wrap sections from the last round. ***

Fan Stitch Round 2:

Step 1: Knit 1 stitch

Step 2: Slip the next 5 stitches from the LH to the RH needle, releasing the triple wraps as you go, which will make 5 elongated stitches.

Step 3: Bring working yarn to the front of your work

Step 4: Slip the 5 elongated stitches from the RH to the LH needle

Step 5: Bring yarn to the back

Step 6: Slip the 5 elongated stitches from the LH to the RH needle

Step 7: Bring yarn to the front

Step 8: Slip the 5 elongated stitches from the RH to the LH needle

Step 9: Bring yarn to the back

Step 10: Slip the 5 stitches to the RH needle

Repeat these 10 steps for each fan section (6 stitches each), until the end of the round.

Fan Stitch Round 3: Purl around.

BODY OF HAT

Knit in the round until piece measures 5.5" from cast on edge.

****Jen's Note: I do 5.5" for someone who doesn't have hair. For someone with hair, you will want to knit approx. 7.5" from cast on edge. ****

CROWN OF HAT

Crown Round 1: (K4, K2tog) repeat parentheses until the end of round. Crown Round 2 - 4: Knit around Crown Round 5: (K3, K2tog) repeat parentheses until the end of round. Crown Round 6 & 7: Knit around Crown Round 8: (K2, K2tog) repeat parentheses until the end of the round. Crown Round 9 & 10: Knit around Crown Round 11: (K1, K2tog) repeat parentheses until the end of the round. Crown Round 11: (K1, K2tog) repeat parentheses until the end of the round. Crown Round 12: Knit around

Cut tail and pull through remaining stitches and weave in all your ends!
